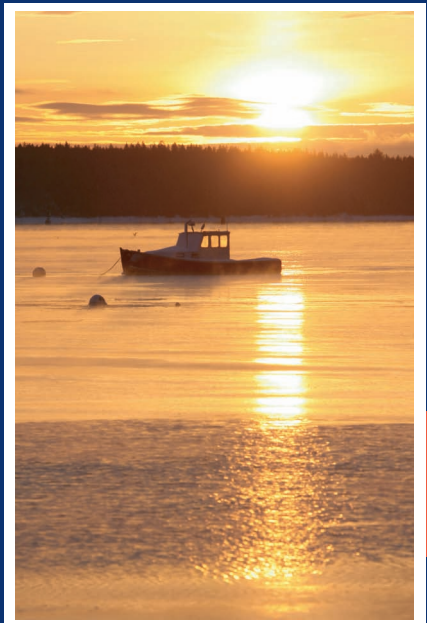

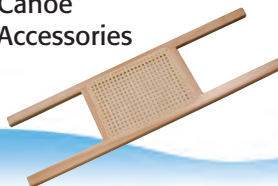

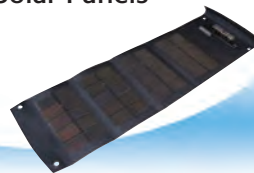

## Searsport Attractions

### *Searsport's in the center of it all !*

**Steamboat Wharf** - fishing, boating, beachcombing. Enjoy the tastes of Maine at one of our many restaurants nearby.

**Mosman Park** – picnicking on the shore of Penobscot Bay; State-of-the-art playground equipment; ball field available; public swim beach.



**Moose Point State Park**- wooded trails and shoreline with picnicking, hiking, and swimming available. Snow shoeing available in the winter season.

**Swan Lake State Park**- fresh-water swimming and boating, north on Mt Ephraim Rd. from the village center.

**Sears Island**- the largest uninhabited island on the east coast, is accessible by causeway from Sears Island Road. Excellent biking and walking, snow shoeing and cross country skiing. Swim, picnic, and watch for seals and the occasional whale. Over one hundred bird species have been observed on the island.

### *Just a short drive away...*

**Fort Point State Park** is less than 10 minutes drive.

Searsport and boasts a lighthouse and fog bell, as well as ruins of Fort Pownal, a beach, boat dock, and wooded picnic sites.

**Fort Knox**, just 20 minutes away on US I is the most visited state historic site in Maine. It now includes access to this region's new attraction...the architectural award-winning **Penobscot Narrows Bridge and Observation Tower** (at right).

Watch for special events throughout the summer, and be sure to visit other attractions within an easy drive of Searsport, including:

**Acadia National Park** (one hour)

**Camden Hills State Park** (30 minutes) and Lincolnville Beach and the ferry to Islesboro (20 minutes)

**Sandy Point Beach** (10 minutes) public swim beach, trails.

## Historic Searsport

The town of Searsport is located near the head of Penobscot Bay on the western shore, six miles north of Belfast. Searsport originated from part of the old Frankfort Plantation of 1760, composed of parts of Prospect and East Belfast. The present day Mill Pond marks the halfway point which was once known as Half Way Creek.

At the time of town incorporation in 1845 there were two rows of frame buildings consisting of shops and homes in Searsport village. The first of the “brick blocks”, known as the Leach Block, was built in 1836 to the south of Mt. Ephraim Road. On the south side of Main Street the Merithew Block was built in 1847 and at one time housed Searsport’s first bank. In 1853 the three-story Smart Building was built on the westerly corner of Mt. Ephraim Road and Main St. During the next three decades most of the other brick structures in town were erected. The last was the Old Merrill Trust Bank, which, in 1891, replaced the Ellis grocery and dry goods shop on the easterly corner of Mosman and Main Streets.

Throughout its history, the town of Searsport has always been connected to the sea: building ships, sailing ships and receiving ships’ cargo. Today, Searsport’s deep-water harbor allows large freighters to come in and out on a weekly basis. And even though David Sears, for whom the town was named, may not have become the generous patron that our founding fathers hoped, the name has served us well, being, as far as anyone knows, the only town named Searsport in the entire world.

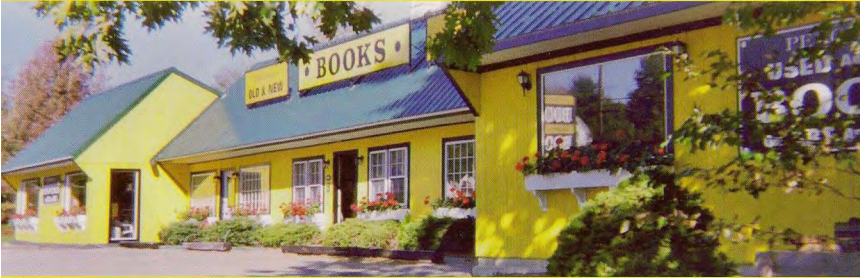
