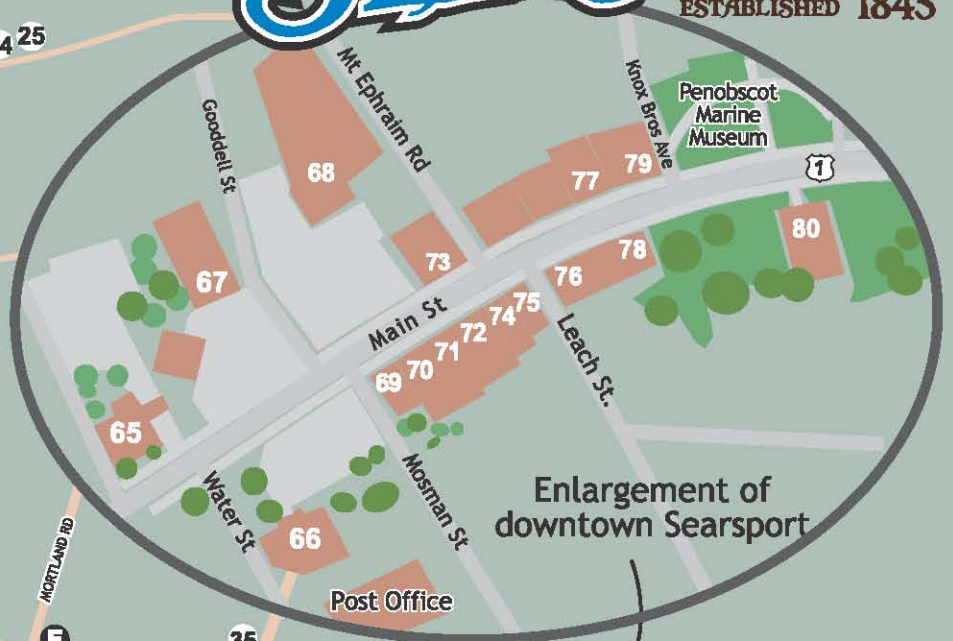

Sears Island, at 941 acres and five miles of coastline, is the largest uninhabited island on the coast of Maine. Its central ridge rises to 185 feet above mean sea level, making it prominently visible throughout the bay. Sears Island includes salt marshes, rocky intertidal areas, sand beaches, eelgrass beds and clam flats.

Try a hike around an uninhabited island connected to the mainland by a causeway.

The walk around Sears Island is actually a walking tour of the upper bay, since you get to look at area landmarks from every direction.
